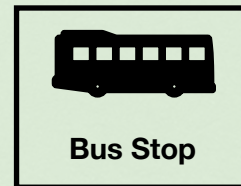


Signs and Symbols

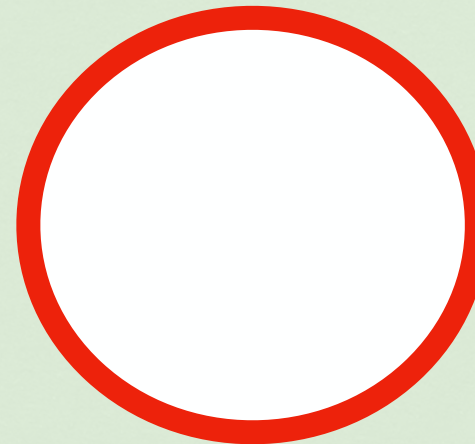


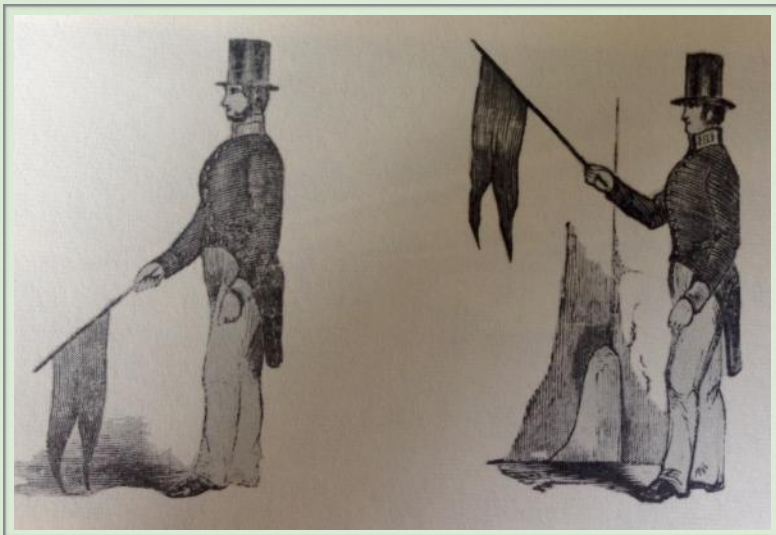

Draw a sign for your bedroom. Is it safe to enter?





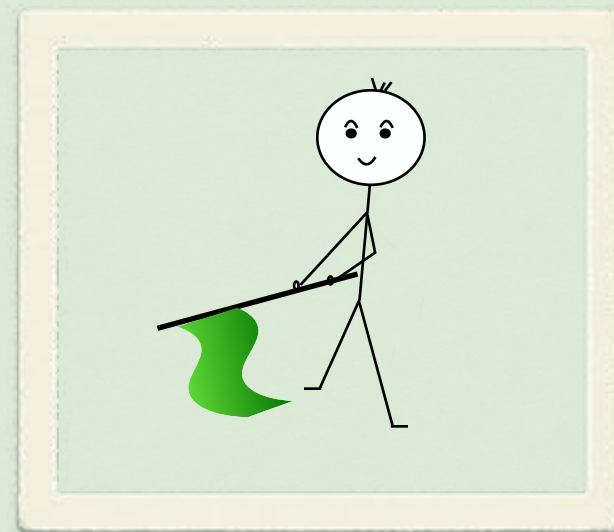
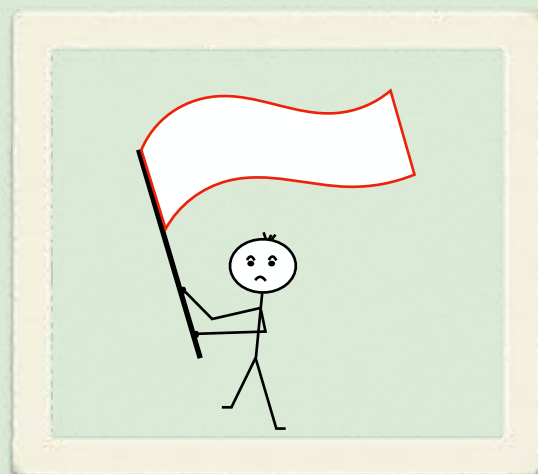
When steam engines were first invented, they needed railway policemen to keep the railways safe.

They stood next to the track and waved a flag to give the engine driver a warning signal.

Make a Signal Flag of your own

What do you think a **green light** meant?



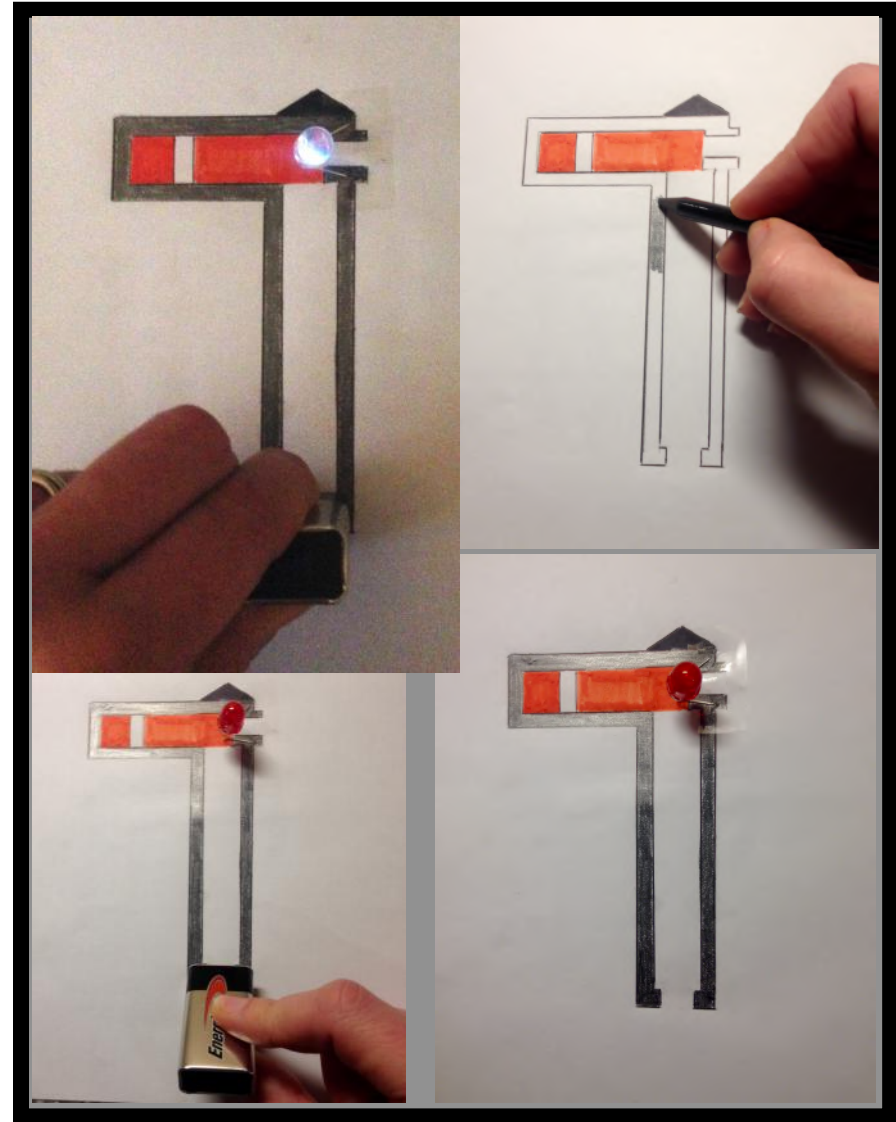
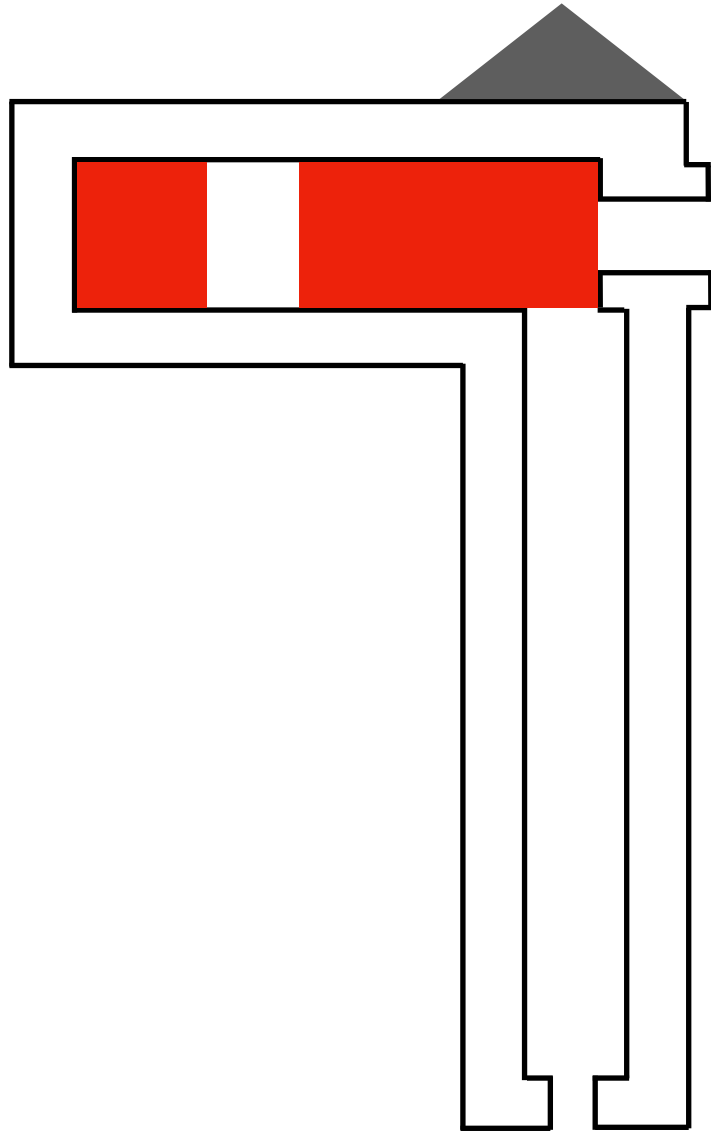
When electricity was invented the railways used signals with lights like these.
